#### FISHING REPORT

Muggy days, showers and afternoon storms have had a very positive effect on the fishing, more often than not overcast showery days give the fish more confidence and combined with the little bit of fresh stirring things up, if I was a fish I'd be out and about. Let's check out this week's fishing report. Good news for anglers leading up towards Christmas - Mud Crabs are on the move around Kauri, Big Tuan and Maaroom Creeks. There are still a few rattlers in amongst them, but the majority of crabs are quite full.

The whole of the Mary River system continues to produce the goods with reports of Grunter, Threadfin Salmon and flathead all the way up to the barrage with herring, prawns or livies being the preferred bait. And for the adrenalin junky there's plenty of bull sharks to keep you entertained. Estuary Cod, Blackall, Grassy Sweetlip and Moses Perch have been in numbers throughout the Sandy Straits on the ledges and up the creeks plus another positive note to these muggy days is that the Mangrove Jack are on fire Jacks have been reported throughout creeks and estuaries anywhere from Burrum Heads to Poona mainly been taken on live baits, mullet strips or suspending lures. Deep Creek has been fishing well for large Jewies and Grunter off the ledges and Summer Whiting and Flathead working the flats on the making tide.


Golden trevally and queen fish are taking medium diving lures in the channel between the Bluff at the bottom of Fraser Island and Moon Point, and schoolie mackerel with the odd spotty are taking small metal slugs throughout the waters of Hervey Bay.

Moon ledge and Sammie's have been popular with catches of Blueys, Grassy Sweetlip, Blackall and Cod and plenty of pelagic action in platypus bay with some small black marlin, Spanish mackerel, spotty mackerel and golden trevally taking large, medium to deep diving lures.

Burrum heads continues to impress with mangrove jack, grunter and Threadfin salmon and the beautiful beach at Woodgate has seen some quality summer whiting, dart and silver trevally.

And lastly don't forget in those windy conditions we have the freshwater option, Lenthalls Dam has been putting on a show with some catching and releasing 30 or more bass and barra in a session. Surface lures seem to be doing the trick.



#### BRUMBY UPDATE!!!

Community Reference
Group (CRG)
Tuan Toolara Feral
Horse Public
Safety Initiative



Keesha Millar and Melissa D'Or, both long-term Poona residents, have been members of the CRG since it's inception in early 2020. The CRG forms part of the Feral Horse Public Safety Initiative of HQPlantations which was established to develop strategies to maintain public safety in relation to the Brumby population in the Tuan Toolara Forestry. We were both in attendance at the most recent meeting on 6<sup>th</sup> November. It has been 12 months since our last CRG meeting, in November 2022, so there were a number of updates we wanted to share with the Poona community.

Rehoming: Rehoming continues to be the preferred method of population management and over the past 10 months 57 horses have been relocated from areas closest to public roads surrounding HQP. Nine of these are currently being ajisted, of which two were born there. A total of 48 horses have been rehomed since January this year by The Brumby Project led by Anna Urhig. Around 60% have been rehomed within Queensland but the remainder have gone to NT, Victoria and NSW. This is a phenomenal effort and the CRG and HQP are grateful for the wonderful work Anna does in training both the horses and potential owners to ensure a successful rehoming. New groups of horses continue to replace those that have been removed so this is a continuous strategy and is likely to increase with the dry weather and movement by the brumbies to source food. Now more than ever new homes are required for these horses; if you or someone you know is interested in rehoming a brumby please contact Anna at thebrumbyproject@gmail.com

Suitability criteria documentation: this process continues to be applied in determining the temperament and health of the horse and the likelihood it will lead to a successful rehoming. Detailed records of each horse captured is being kept. The criteria applies a rating scale from one to ten, with the higher the number the more likely the horse is suitable for rehoming. Unsuitable horses fall into a rating less than 5 and these horses are euthanised on site, as ethically and humanely as possible. This has been the case for two horses from the 57 captured this year. This is a very difficult decision for those involved but horses not scoring high enough on the suitability criteria scale are not going to be successfully rehomed and can be a danger to themselves, other horses and/or humans.

Aerial survey: a recent aerial survey, using thermal imaging techniques to determine numbers and distribution of horses within the Tuan Toolara forestry, was conducted over a one-week period in August. This is the third time since 2021 this survey has been undertaken though on this occasion the survey area was extended to include the northern end of the property. In calculating the number of horses additional methods such as dung surveys are applied and this indicates numbers remain similar to previous counts at around 2000.

Fencing: the fencing strategy continues to be undertaken at HQP expense and large areas along the Maryborough Cooloola and Boonooroo roads have been completed to date. We will continue to see brumbies along these areas for some years despite the fencing, as it takes time for the horses to learn that there is fencing there. For this reason, this is a longer-term strategy with no immediate results expected to be seen.

Fertility Control: a UniSQ Honours student is currently undertaking a literature review on this topic and in 2024 will commence research on the viability of applying this method of population control to the Tuan Toolara brumbies. As mentioned in previous Poona Post updates, New Zealand and the USA have successfully applied this method to smaller numbers of brumby populations. The feasibility on a large scale, as the numbers we have in Tuan Toolara, is still to be determined and it is hoped this research will be useful for this.
