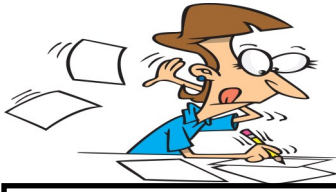

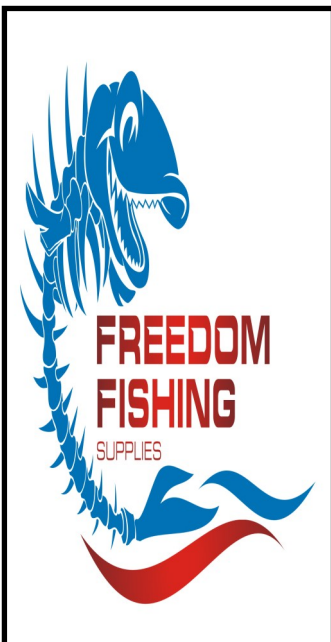

There has been plenty of fishing action happening this fortnight, whether it is fresh or salt water, out of a boat or off the bank, the reports keep coming in. Let's look at what's been caught.

The majority of anglers have been hitting the waters of the Great Sandy Straits and with plenty of fish on the bite – Barramundi have been hitting live baits and lures with aggression as are the Mangrove Jack. Poona, Kauri, Swan and Tuan creeks, have all reported some great fish.

Tuan has produced some great catches of summer and winter whiting, mainly in the deep waters outside the channel. Yabbies have been working a treat, and the bloody biodegradable gulp worms are also doing their job.

Tinnanbar and Kimbackers ledge have been reporting Estuary Cod, Blackall and Grassy Sweetlip and Fig Tree along with Deep Creek have produced large Threadfin Salmon, Barra and Grunter.

The mud crabs are still on the run throughout the Sandy Straits, with mixed reports about quality, make sure you throw the empty ones back to fill out.

The Mary and Susan River systems have had fisho's landing Threadfin Salmon, Barra, Grunter and Cod as well as some Silver and Black Bream still kicking around that kilo mark.

Rooney's and the Gutters are fishing well with Red Emperor, Scarlets, Sweetlip, Blue Māori Cod and Hussar. Plus, plenty of Tuna and Schoolie Mackerel being landed around Wathumba.

Our fresh lovers have also been reeling in some great catches. Bass in Tinana Creek and the fresh reaches of the Mary.

Lenthals is also fishing well with lots of Barra being landed, most are now around that 80cm mark. Still waiting for those horses that must be out there.

Let's have a look at the brag board.

First up is Anthony with a ripper of a cobia. The smile says it all.



Matthew landed some nice threadfin in the Mary.



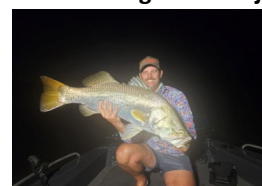
James had a successful trip to Toogoom landing this grunter.

Last up is Brodie who had an awesome night out in the Straits hitting the barra.



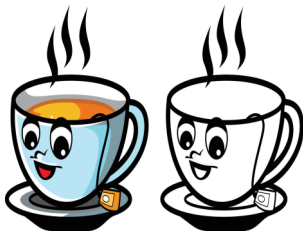

Around 1600 accidental house fires happened in Queensland in 2025.

Home fire safety starts with having interconnected

smoke alarms that alert you to fire faster. Families should also make and practise an escape plan so everyone will know what to do and where to go.

Smoke alarm legislation

By 1 January 2027, all Queensland households are required to have interconnected, photoelectric smoke alarms. Caravans and motorhomes will also need a photoelectrical smoke alarm installed.

Key Messages

The key messages delivered by the creative concept are:

- Interconnected smoke alarms and an escape plan save lives.
- Your family's safety is priceless.
- New smoke alarm laws are coming. Are you compliant?
- Interconnected smoke alarms. When one goes off, they all go off.
- Find out if you're compliant.
- Plan to survive.

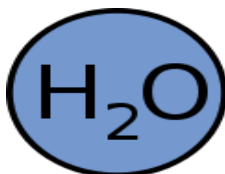

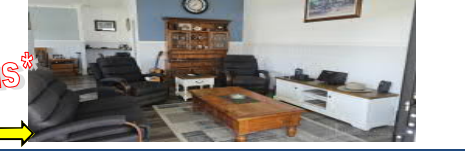

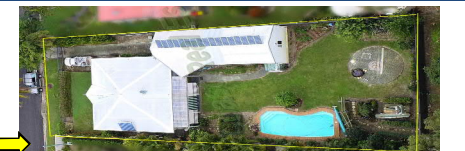
