The end of the financial year is already here and we are busier than ever. The end of May saw the successful running of the SSRFB's Family Fun Day and a donation from the PCPA of nearly \$1000. Then in June we had a very successful Biggest Morning Tea raising over \$1000 for the Cancer Council, thanks to Cathy Rose and a wonderful team of helpers. The work on Market Alley improvements is nearly finished as a result of the hard work and commitment of our volunteers. Also, work has finally started on the extensions to the hall. For an organisation to achieve so much is a tribute to our volunteers and helps to make Poona the place to be.

One of the stalwarts and great supporters of Poona is moving on. Ellen Wilson has been a member of the PCPA from the start, working tirelessly to improve our community. We will be farewelling Ellen at the hall 10am on 13<sup>th</sup> July. Please come along and give Ellen the farewell she well and truly deserves.

We are continuing with our end of month event which is free and open to all comers. For details on events scheduled see the "What's on for the Month" section of this publication.

For some time now, we have been working with Council to better manage green waste from Council controlled foreshore areas. The procedures in place have been reviewed and some changes will be implemented to improve outcomes. There will be a letter box drop of the whole town to explain these changes. In addition, we are working with Council to have a trial of a Council chipper, operated by Council officers, to chip green waste from private properties. Times would align with clean ups before the storm season and when required by demand. More on how this will work in the coming months.

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## FISHING REPORT

How the year is flying by, as another glorious week gets ticked off the calendar our local anglers have had a smorgasbord of fishing available to them. Let's check out what's been caught and where.

Again, this week we had multiple area's firing and a large variety of fish being landed across the Fraser Coast. Wintertime is notorious for big bream both Black and Silver and most being landed in the Mary, Susan & Burrum River systems and their connecting creeks anywhere around structure or snags with most using Mullet Gut or Chicken Strips as bait. Some even adding the element of scents such as garlic or aniseed smells.

Pelagic fish have continued to entertain. Putting on a show throughout The Great Sandy Straits best catches has been reported on small metal slugs on the cast or 2-2.5m diving lures on the troll. Anchoring out off a local ledge or reef such as Kinbackers, Moon, The Arti or Fig Tree has had some surprising results with Cod, Blackall, Scarlets up to 50cm, Squire, Grassy Sweetlip and Coral Trout being temped.

The Threadys are still present mostly down river towards Beaver rock and river heads with Grunter, Jew and blue Salmon being caught also - most have been using livies whether it be mullet, herring or prawns.

At this time of year everyone is out enjoying the Winter Whiting Craze, with no minimum size and bag limit of 50 most anglers have been bagging out, best places are spots like Gatakers Bay, Toogoom, Burrum and of course drifting in the deeper waters in the Straits.

Arrow squid are still on the bite in the Straits with a few tigers being reported. Anglers have been targeting these giant tiger squid either in the waters around the coffee rock ledges flicking a jig or grabbing your hand spear and going for a night walk around the rocks down Boonooroo and Tuan. There are some decent muddies still showing up in pots. So worth putting them in. Tailor are starting to show up in the Straits, hitting Halco twisty's on a fast retrieve or hard bodies on the troll.

For the big boaties who got out wide, the rewards where sweet. With everything from trophy reds and snapper to monster Spanish mackerel and cobia.

Jon went to a Council meeting yesterday about Coastal Futures. This project is in its final stage with residents invited to provide feedback on the recommendations for Poona outlined below. Poona responded well to the earlier stages of this project.

Regional actions including Planning Response, Emergency Response, Community Awareness and Education, Natural Ecosystem Strengthening, and Monitoring. Key regional actions for Poona include: • Expansion of the Natural Environment Program to include foreshore and wetland habitat management. • Establish a program to deal with illegal encroachment into foreshore reserve and illegal vegetation clearing. • Council will develop practical guidance for adaptation on private land. Maintain road network: sections of road potentially exposed to coastal hazards include Boronia Drive. Remove or formalise unapproved erosion controls: remove unapproved shoreline erosion controls along Boronia Drive and consider upgrading with appropriate shoreline erosion protection structures. Longterm options Relocate public assets and infrastructure when upgrading: Poona Foreshore areas are exposed to future coastal hazards. Relocating assets within this area may be more cost effective than upgrading with a coastal hazard resilient design. Options will be investigated when considering the useful life of existing assets
