Council Agenda – Information on the Council's Palm Frond Collection Program was delivered to homes last week. Please be advised that this is strictly for Palm trees on Council managed land only and not for dumping of green waste from homes. Council considers dumping of other green waste as illegal dumping and will be treated as an offence, resulting in fines being issued to offenders.

Please use the Boonoroo Waste Facility to dispose of up to one tonne of green-waste free-of-charge. Take a trailer or ute load of clean green waste and on your 8th visit you will receive a voucher for 1m3 of mulch free. Additional green waste initiatives for residents are currently being negotiated with Council.

Boat Ramp – Good news for some and bad news for others is that the boat ramp is off the agenda for the time being. This is, and always has been, a State government decision and we know very little else. You will be advised when we get more information on the matter.

HOT FLASHES SANDY STRAITS RFB

It is time to make sure your whole family has prepared for a bushfire. We know our risk living at Poona and it is time to refresh your Bush Fire Survival Plan with all members of your family. If you plan to leave early, then you must leave your home well before the bushfire threatens or impacts our road. If you stay, then it is time to check your Bushfire Emergency Kit to see that it is well organised. Check that your property is able to withstand the impact of a bushfire. Do you have well maintained fire fighting resources and equipment and protective clothing? Clean all your gutters and tidy your property. Check with your Plan, Act and Survive pamphlet that we gave out last year or pick up a new one, from the hall, if you do not have one.

If you are cleaning your yard and burning a small stack - Make sure you have water at the ready. An old wet mop is also a great tool. Check the wind and be aware of smoking out the neighbours. Make sure it is a still cool evening. We have already had examples of neighbour's burning small stacks and before they know it, have had it run up a tree causing an uncontrolled fire. Call 000 if there is a fire.

FISHING REPORT

I reckon nothing beats our Queensland Winters - how gorgeous has the weather been! I think Mother Nature may have one last cold snap in store for us so pull out your winter woollies and hit the water because the fishing is Hot! Hot! Hot.! Let's check out this week's report. Let's start off this week's report with the heart of our area – The Mary River. Anglers have been battling with big tides and run coming off the full moon but have reaped the rewards with Threadfin Salmon plus monster black and silver bream. Grunter up to and over 60cm long. Head then out into the Great Sandy Straits via the mouth of the River down through the Turkey Straits, locals have been spoilt for choice with many species readily available to them. Reports this week are flooding in fisho's are catching plenty of Flathead in the shallow waters around drains and drop offs. Some of the popular bait displays working are larger curly or shad tailed soft plastics or you could try shallow to medium diving hard body lures. The Summer Whiting numbers have improved so targeting the mud banks around the mangroves say out of Tuan or Maaroom has been quite lucrative. The Yabbies or worms continue to produce the goods but on such clear wind free days you should try targeting whiting on surface poppers you'll be very surprised on how much fun you can have. Moving across the channel over along the Islands ledges and drop off boaties are still landing Squirey Snapper, Nannygai, Coral Bream also known as Grassy Sweetlip, Blackall and Cod not to mention all the bi catches of pelagic fish such as Spottie and Grey Mackerel, Talior,

Golden Trevally and Queenies.
You'll have the best chance on the reef fish bottom bashing with squid or livies where the pelagic species tend to hunt on the surface so a floated ganged pillie or flesh strip would do the trick. The outer reefs over the bottom wide bay bar there's plenty of reports of Pearl Perch, Coral Trout, Red and Spangled Emperor plus many species of
