PCPA COMMITTEE REPORT:

Welcome to another edition of the Poona Post.

Boat Ramp. At the last Community meeting, Bruce Saunders addressed a comment I made that the boat ramp project was off the agenda. Bruce advised the meeting that the boat ramp was indeed on track with a significant amount of work being done in the background and that funding has not been affected. Although no firm commencement date was provided.

Boat Ramp Inspection. On the topic of boat ramps, as part of a Council boat ramp maintenance program, the existing ramp will be closed on 5 Oct for an inspection.

Pre-Storm-Season Clean-up Day. Council will be conducting a Clean-up Day on the oval on Wed 13 October from 0730. Council will be supplying a chipper on the northern side of the oval and you can bring a ute/trailer load of woody material for chipping - (That's tree branches/prunings etc, no bigger than 150mm/6inches). No palm fronds or grass. Additionally, a pile of chipped mulch is available on southern side of the oval. You can collect from the pile, but no machinery will be available, you will need to load by hand. Signage will be erected on the day and there will be guides to direct you.

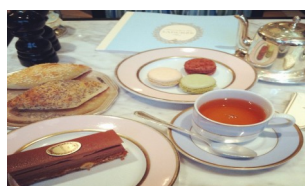

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FISHING REPORT

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We hope everyone is enjoying the school holidays – let's check out what's been happening across the Fraser Coast.

The Mary River is very salty at the moment and anglers have been landing quality Threadfin Salmon around the 10 kilos throughout the entire river system. Trolling deep diving lures around Copenhagen Bend and Dundathu Strait has had exceptional results on both Threadfin Salmon and Barramundi.

Live baiting around Beaver Rock and the drop off up to Turkey Creek has produced Grunter, Jew, Black and Silver Bream all in good quantities and sizes.

River Heads has also been on fire with Threadfin Salmon, Large Flathead, a few quality Tailor and the odd GT.

Over towards the Island at McKenzie's Ledge our Fisho's have been landing mixed bags of reef fish including Estuary Cod, Blackall, Scarlett's and purple tusk Fish. The car dump reef out from Wanggoolba Creek has also been reporting similar catches.

Fishing the Flats on the making tide between Rocky Creek and Yankee Jack including the Sheridan flats has seen summer whiting up to 40cm. Although not so much in quantity but the size is certainly there. And flicking either small hard bodied or soft plastic lures around in the same area on the same tide has seen some monster flathead landed.

Mixed bags of reef fish again coming from the coffee rock ledges and reef such as Deep Creek, Kimbackers, Flat Rock, Tinnanbar and the Hole in the wall, and quality Grassy Sweetlip landed at the gravel grounds.

Trolling 90mm-120mm medium diving lures anywhere in the shipping channels and you're bound to get onto a few nice mackerel, Mack Tuna, Queenies, Trevally and Tailor. Trolling two lures at once with one being reflective and the other being dull has worked a treat.

Mangrove Jack and Grunter have been on the chew with anglers having success throughout the Estuary System on Fraser Island, the diamonds, Maaroom, Butha and Kauri Creeks. Live baiting has been the preferred method however soaking a piece of mullet fillet or flicking a suspending lure around the mangroves, moored boats or rock ledges has also had great result. Remember, Red is Mangrove Jacks favourite colour, it also works well for Cod.

Even though we haven't seen much rain, there are still a few quality chocolate mud crabs around. Well worth soaking a pot or two.

Lets have a look at the brag board.

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SANDY STRAITS RURAL FIRE BRIGADE

Our volunteers are very busy assisting and conducting Hazard Reduction Burns around our villages. There will be smoke in the area, so please be aware and take care on the roads if the Smoke Waring Signs are out.

There are 3 levels of official Bushfire Warnings. You should be able to recognise them and act accordingly.

1. **ADVICE:** – If one is issued for Poona it indicates a fire has started. This means monitor conditions and Review your Bushfire Survival Plan. The second is
2. **WATCH & ACT:** - That means conditions are changing. There is a heightened level of threat! Start taking action and follow your Bushfire Survival Plan. Be prepared to protect yourself and your family. Stage 3 is
3. **EMERGENCY WARNING:-** If this is issued for Poona you are in Danger. Enact your Bushfire Survival Plan and make sure you are ready for any emergency. Prepare for the fire to impact where you are if you are not able to leave. Always tune in to local ABC radio for updates and have a look at the current bushfire map. – ruralfire.qld.gov.au/map/pages/default.aspx. Stay informed!

If you do see a fire always ring 000 to enable your volunteers to be deployed quickly.

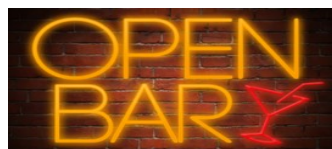

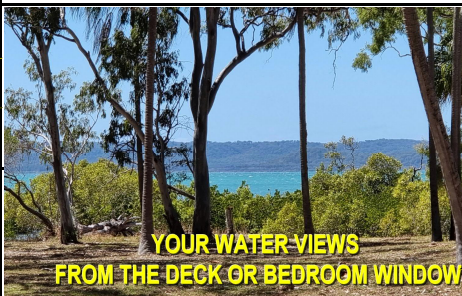

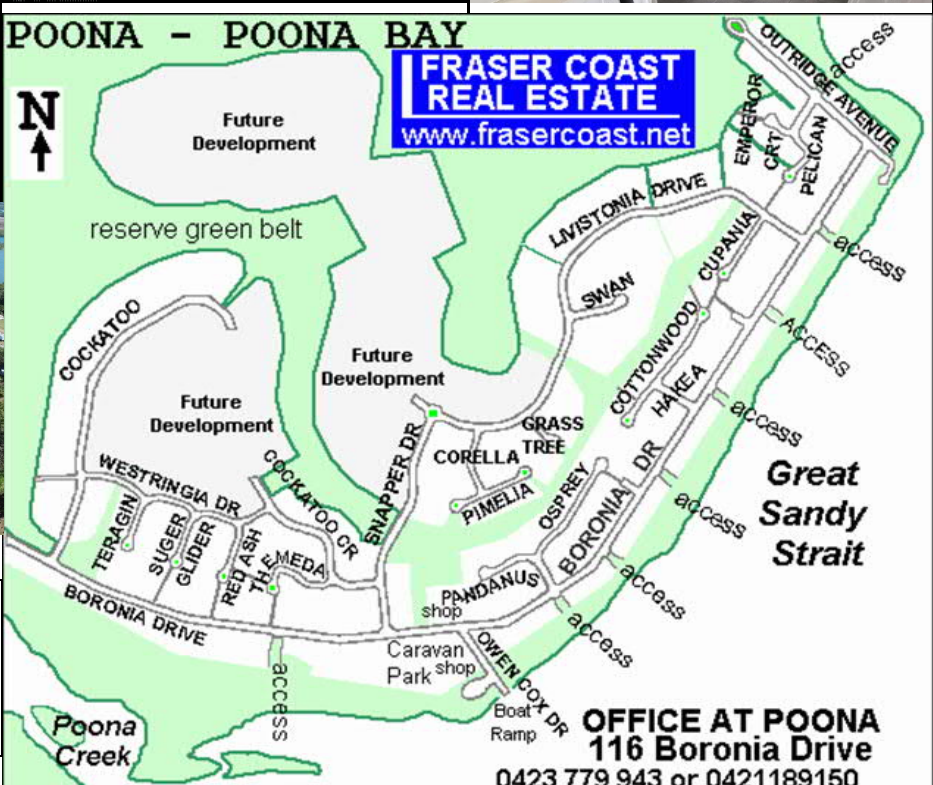
