FISHING REPORT

Hot days and the threat of afternoon storms were the combined elements that got both fish and fisherman fired up over the last fortnight. Let's take a look at the report.

The Mary River continued to fire on all cylinders. It's still very salty at the moment with plenty of run in the water. Threadfin Salmon have been on the top of the hit list with most anglers trolling deep driving hard body lures between the hi-way Bridge and Copenhagen bend, while others kicked back at Brothers Island with a couple of livey's. Shore based anglers have been doing quite well from the Pontoon at the Lamington Bridge using either fresh bait or live shrimp. Beaver Rock has also been fishing well with Threadfin and Blue Salmon, Black and Silver Bream, large Jew and Grunter reported all the way to River Heads including the Susan River.

Into the Sandy Straits now where the reports have been coming in thick and fast with everything from Threadfin and Blue Salmon, Grunter, Barra, Mangrove Jack and Estuary Cod throughout the entire estuary system, and large summer Whiting and Flathead populating the sand flats.

Sports fisho's have been in their element with the pelagic action between Wathumba and the Break Sea spit. Spanish mackerel, Long Tail Tuna and G. T's taking a variety of lures from Deep Divers to poppers and everything in between.

The Burrum 8 mile is loaded with Spotted and schoolie Mackerel. Casting and retrieving metal slugs or blades on a rapid retrieve has produced fish, however dropping the same lures to the bottom and jigging them back to the boat had an awesome effect with most anglers landing their bag limits.

The inshore reefs such as the Gables, Sammie's and the Artificial have been producing a mixed bag of quality fish including Black spot Tusk Fish, Estuary Cod, Grassy Sweetlip and Blackall and reports of G. T's in numbers throughout Hervey Bay waters.

With high winds and off tides, it seems the freshwater fishing has been on most anglers agender this week, Bass and Barra thrive on these hot muggy conditions and its sensational fun! Fishing the surface early mornings for bass around Tiaro or Teddington has been most popular.

There are 9 things you need to do to keep your family safe as it is now Storm Season.

Maintain your yard and balcony. Secure or stow items that could be blown around in strong winds.

Clean your gutters, down pipes and drains to prevent blockage.

Trim trees and branches that could fall onto your home or the neighbor's home.

Fix any damage to your roof including missing or damaged tiles.

Check your insurance policy.

Make a HOME EMERGENCY PLAN!!!

Have a location to go to for shelter. Don't forget the pets.

Prepare an **EMERGENCY KIT** in case you lose power or need to be evacuated.

Listen to your local radio station for weather warnings or look up the BOM (Bureau of Meteorology, Gympie radar) on your phone for updates.

The Brigade has been called out to several non-legitimate calls last month. This causes the volunteers great concern being called out late at night, to a nonevent. Please make sure all calls to 000 are Legitimate. Please ensure all fire access tracks are clear. Do not throw your rubbish over the fire tracks or into the scrub behind. PLEASE take it to the tip. Our talks with Council last week were very co-operative. Council took photos of all the tracks and debris and sent around machinery to clear a path for our appliances. Our appliances need to have easy access. Last week's large fire that we attended, took off quickly even though the ground was boggy and wet. The tops were still very dry and caught fire extremely rapidly, making it a very difficult fire to contain. Please do not be complacent.

Have you packed your evacuation kit, your emergency kit and do you have an emergency plan? Suggestion lists are available from the hall or the Brigade. If you have time to spare you can become a Volunteer, fire fighter or a support member. We would love to have you. Training supplied. Take care and stay safe please.




