Morning guys, here is this fortnights report

With the amount of water that has gone into our systems, fishing the mouths is proving to be the better option. The salt is starting to push back through and the next couple of weeks we will see huge changes on the fishing front, water temperatures are starting to drop and transformation in water clarity will be noticeable. Just pray to the gods for some good weather and we will have fish on.

Already we have had fisho's reporting in with some great catches of prawn's and quality mud crabs.

Barramundi are on hunt in the dirty water at Lake Lenthals, floating the top with zmann goat toad and hard leg frogs into the late afternoon have been successful.

Flathead are hanging on the edges chasing the bait in the warm water. They are pretty hungry and are hitting everything, soft plastics, hard bodies and yabbie's or prawns are all getting results.

Tuan, Swan and Kauri creeks have been the hot spots for Jack. These aggressive fighting fish are definitely a challenge but very addictive to chase.

Ledges such as, Fig Tree, Mackenzie's and Tinnanbar have produced a mixed bag of reef fish including a few legal Scarlet's, Blackall and Grassy Sweetlip.

Grunter and threadfin salmon have been caught toward the mouth of the estuaries and river systems. Large Barra are about in the Straits on the sand flats at high tide.

The inshore reefs such as Sammy's, Moon Ledge and Mickey's has been producing a mixed bag of reefies including Blackall, grassy Sweetlip, Purple tusk fish and Estuary Cod.

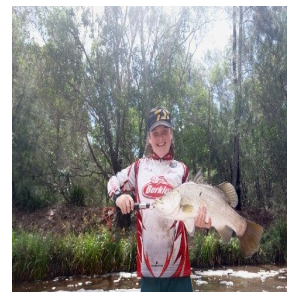
Lets have a look at the brag board.

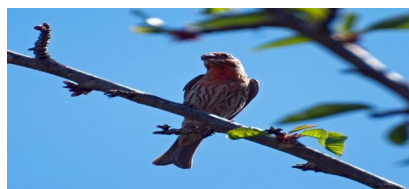

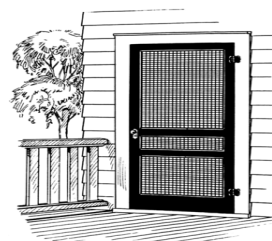

Join Judy Sumner and the team on a free guided bushwalk. Judy is our local enthusiast photographer and birdwatcher who knows these trails extremely well and it has been her canvas for many a great picture/postcard.

The walk will commence on **Easter Saturday (16th April) at 6.30am** commencing at the Gazebo at the Point (Fig Tree), Qutridge Ave. Judy will be at the Point from 5.50am for those wanting to also add a sunrise to their morning experience (sunrise - 6.04am). For those that follow her on Facebook/Instagram this is part of the area where Judy gets all those wonderful sunrise photos.

You will find the morning walk a most enjoyable experience. This relatively easy walk will showcase some magnificent birdlife that abounds in Poona. The walk will include parts of the foreshore which is a noted bird roosting area and is then followed by the Melaleuca & Wallum Circuit (1.8 ~~km~~ ^{km}). The latter again abounds in wildlife.

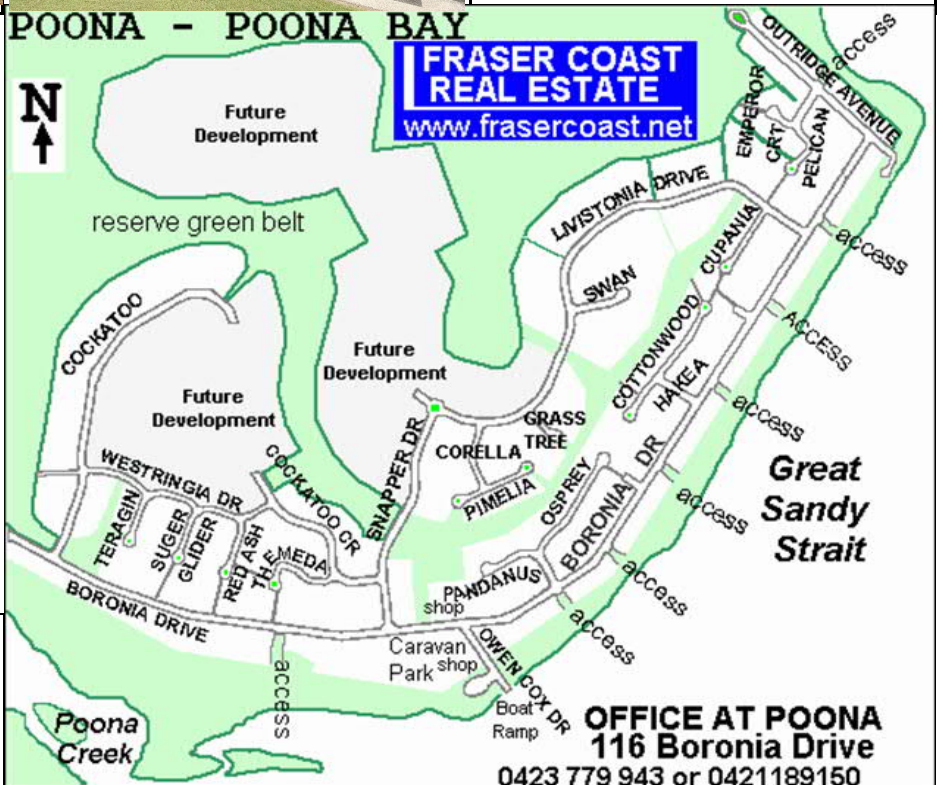
