Bruce explained that this will mean dredging at the existing boat ramp and the hope that material from that dredging will be bagged and used for Protection Barrier instead of being taken away.

FISHING REPORT

Hi guys, here is this fortnights fishing report.

No matter what sort of fishing you're into these past couple of weeks have really produced the goods. With everything from bread-and-butter fish to trophy reef fishing coming over the sides of boats.

Anglers have been targeting Tiger Squid either in the waters around the coffee rock ledges flicking a jig or grabbing your hand spear and going for a night walk around the rocks down Boonooroo/Tuan

The Winter Whiting are still on the chew with possession limits being achieved and they are good quality -23-25cm, especially since the water temperatures have dropped those few degrees. Trying out along the foreshore down the bay or in the deep water between the sputnik and Tinnanbah

For the bigger boats getting out chasing the reefies was possibly with much lighter winds. Cod, Snapper, Reds and Spangled Emperor. With plenty of Mackerel and Cobia down there to stretch your arms. Did we mention Snapper? Yes, we are seeing lots coming over the sides.

The Mary River has been home to some monstrous Bream up to that 1.5Kg mark some solid Grunter and Cod. Plus, the bonus of ducking in behind river heads point to catch the odd Jew and Threadfin Salmon.

Still some great Mud Crabs being potted, and we are getting hot reports of some great quality prawns.

Lets have a look at some local catches.

Burning Stacks

Hi. What weather extremes we are experiencing! Your, Volunteer fire fighters at Sandy Strait RFB, have had a lot of requests for information on burning stacks.

Providing the adequate precautions are taken to prevent spread of fire, the following fires may be lit without a permit:

- 1: Fires less than 2 metres in all directions (these fires are not exempt during fire bans and you must obtain a permit from the fire warden.)
- 2: Barbeques and campfires (for cooking) enclosed in a fireplace, constructed to prevent the escape of fire or ember.
- 3: Smoke from your fire can negatively impact on your community and neighbours.
- 4: Burn late afternoon and when there is no wind and it is safe to do so. Have an adequate supply of water and firefighting equipment and personnel on hand.
- 5: Notify all neighbours before you burn.

With the prolific regrowth of understory grasses, weeds and trees there may be a very active fire season coming. So please help by clearing your garden and land and visiting the tip. Sandy Straits R F Brigade has had many requests for assistance, and we are endeavouring to help where our limited resources can be stretched. Volunteers are required and very welcome!! Both active and support!

If you plan to mechanically clear native vegetation to burn, you may need a separate permit for clearing vegetation under Queensland's Vegetation Management Laws.

Congratulations to Wayne Sorreneson, who is once again our Fire Warden. He is from Forestry and can be phoned on 54882112 to obtain a permit.
