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FISHING REPORT

The days have certainly been heating up and the winds have been kinder. Whether you headed wide or fished the rivers and estuaries, the fish were hitting those baits with aggression. Let's look at the report.

Tinnanbah ledge has been producing some quality reef fish including estuary cod, Blackall and Squire up to 40cm and Poona has been reporting quality Flathead in numbers working the sand flats on the making tide.

Trolling the deeper channels have paid off for Anglers with a mixed catch of Spottie, Schoolie and grey mackerel taking medium diving lures from 90-150mm with Tailor landed as well.

Tailor are also being taken off the beach at Poona and Boonooroo and there are great reports coming in from the back beach of Fraser.

Maaroom and the surrounding estuary system has seen some monster summer whiting up to 40 cm. The preferred bait has been worms or yabbies but for the sports fisherman, chasing those elbow slappers using poppers or pencils, sure does get the adrenalin going.

The inshore protected reefs such as the Artificial, Mickey's and Sammie's, were a little quite over the last fortnight however anglers were still able to get a good feed of Grassy Sweetlip, Snapper, Moses Perch, Estuary Cod and Blackall.

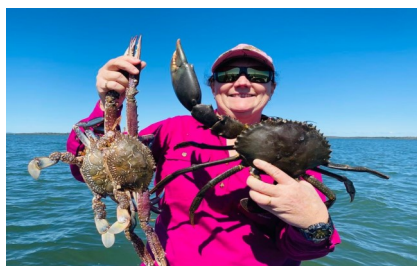
Winter Whiting reports are still coming in, Toogoom, Burrum Heads, Gatakers and drifting the Straits are all producing.

Mud and Sand crabs are are being potted so worth soaking a pot.

With Snapper and Pearl Perch both being back open many fishos have been heading out wide and landing some great catches.

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REPORTING FIRES



Hi Poona Community

There is only one number to call to report a fire or burning stack. PHONE 000.

Do not ring members of the Sandy Straits brigade or come to the station. The immediate call to make is to triple zero. Fire Communications will then contact one of us immediately and we form a crew speedily and get to the fire much faster.

Last month I spoke about burning stacks and since then we have had community members still doing the wrong thing. Please help the community and your neighbours by reading below again.

Providing the adequate precautions are taken to prevent spread of fire, the following fires may be lit without a permit:

Fires less than 2 metres in all directions (these fires are not exempt during fire bans and you must obtain a permit from the fire warden.)

Barbeques and campfires (for cooking) enclosed in a fireplace, constructed to prevent the escape of fire or ember.

Smoke from your fire can negatively impact on your community and neighbours.

Burn late afternoon and when there is no wind, and it is safe to do so. Clear around your pile to bare earth. Have an adequate supply of water, firefighting equipment, and people on hand.

Notify all neighbours before you start a burn.

Note, stacks of mulch may self-ignite /combust, (we had one such combustion / thermogenesis experience last week, here in Poona). If you have a pile of mulch or wood chips please spread them now, before fire season. You can feel how hot the centre of your pile is, by putting you hand inside the middle of the stack. **STAY SAFE AND SEE YOU AT THE EXPO!**

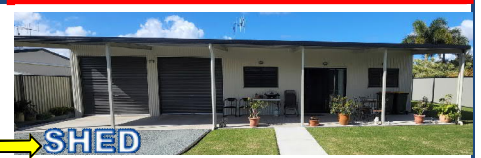

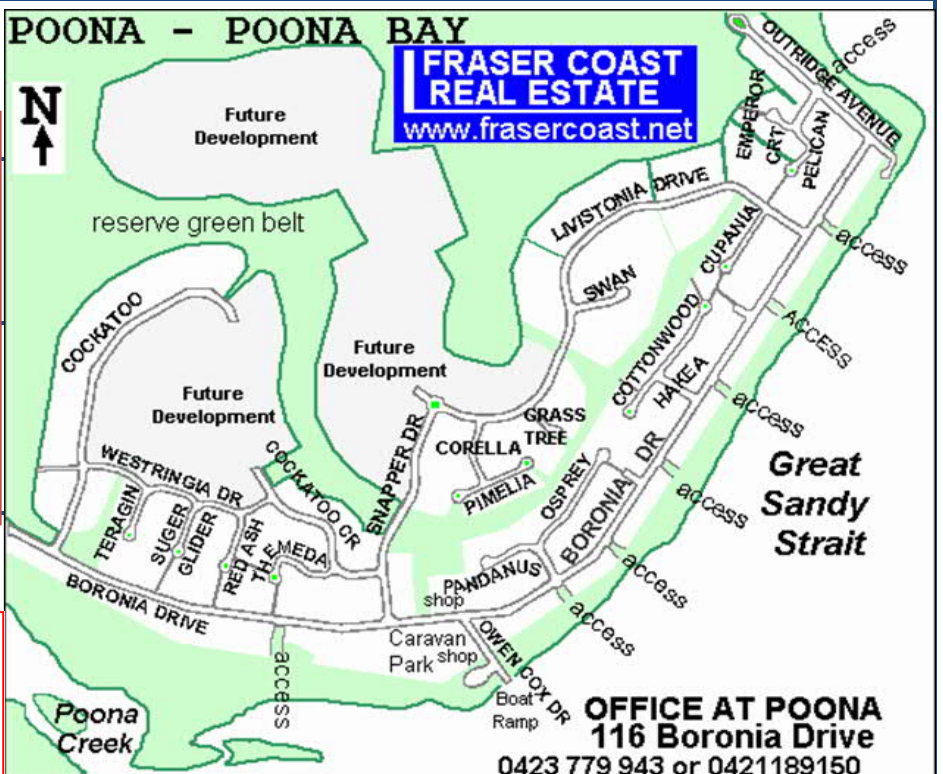
