#### FISHING REPORT

With week one of the school holidays nearly done, heading to one of our local beaches with the kiddies and a fishing rod is always a great day. Summer seems well on its way, and we are only a few weeks into spring, and with the possibility of a storm or two in the afternoons the muggy conditions sure do stir things up. Let's have a look at this fortnights report.

With quite a few windy days this fortnight, freshwater fishing has been on most anglers' agendas. Bass and Barra thrive on these hot muggy conditions and its sensational fun! Fishing the surface early mornings for bass around Tinana or Teddington has been most popular.

The mouths of the creeks are still producing the goods, mostly fishing at Burrum and River Heads, fishos have been reporting good catches of bream, whiting and flathead and some really nice Threadfin Salmon.

The Sandy Straits is still fishing well, the huge summeries have moved in along with the flathead and some decent silver bream.

In protected waters in the Straits boaties have been rewarded with nice Blackall, mosses perch and cod on the reefs and for those who got out on the good days to the gutters, came home with some ripper catches of Scarlets up to 8kg, Cod, good eating size Parrot and Sweetlip.

The Urangan pier is a great place to go for a family day out, bream, whiting and flathead have been landed in the shallow channel, and out at the end of the pier, anglers have been getting amongst a variety of Mackerel, Mac Tuna, Jew and Trevally. Sports fisho's are in their element with more pelagic action than you can throw a lure at. Long Tail Tuna, G.T's, Cobia and Spanish Mackerel have been taken on a variety of lures from skirts to poppers, Slugs to Spoons and deep divers to Surface poppers. If you're lucky enough to be headed over to the back beach of Fraser, we are still getting great reports of Tailor and lots of Dart for the kids to have some fun with.

I was also asked to remind the community of putting ICE in their mobile phone's contact list. ICE or "In Case of Emergency" is the number emergency services will FIND and dial if you are in an accident. So put your close contact in your mobile as ICE.


