COVID 19 UPDATE

As has been widely published in the media, from 17th December 2021, all committee members and volunteers who support the Association will need to be double vaccinated to be able to enter the hall precincts. Additionally, any members or visitors who enter the hall precincts must be vaccinated.

By law, you must be able to prove that you are vaccinated, either by the Qld Check-in App, Vaccination Record Card or Proof of Immunisation Certificate issued by Medicare. If you have a medical exemption for vaccination, you must have a certificate from your doctor.

You must show us any of these before we can let you into the hall.

FISHING REPORT

The wind, rain and storms may have kept most fisho's in the rivers and creeks lately, but nevertheless, the fishing was awesome. Let's have a look at the report.

The Threadfin Salmon are widespread in the Mary River at the moment, however the largest quantities have been landed between the Susan River and walkers point. Quality Grunter and Silver bream are also being landed. Remember its still closed season on our saltwater Barra so if you do catch one treat with kid gloves and release.

The mud crabs have also been on the move in the river with the best catches between the Granville and Lamington bridges. Once again the Burrum River had plenty of action with queen fish and golden trevally at the mouth and some huge Grunter, mangrove jack and threadfin salmon further up the river. Toogoom is living up to its reputation with good quantities of large

Toogoom is living up to its reputation with good quantities of large flathead taken on shallow diving lures and soft plastics with the odd grunter taken on live bait.

Gatakers Bay has been reporting a lot of pelagic action with golden trevally, schoolie mackerel and queen fish, and from the bottom, a few nice coral trout have been landed.

Black spot tusk fish, affectionately known as bluey's, have been landed at the artificial reef, along with large estuary cod and Blackall.

In the Great Sandy Straits, Tuan, Butha, and Kauri creek all reporting good quality mangrove jack taken on live bait, mullet strips and small shallow diving lures. While walking the flats has produced some great results with flathead and nice summer whiting.

Tinnanbar ledge has been producing a mixed bag of quality reef fish including bluey's and grassy Sweetlip.

For those chasing that big adrenalin rush – Great reports coming in from the top of the island with quite a few Black Marlin being landed. They are around the 30kg mark, huge fun.

The Barra are still on out at Lenthalls with some nice fish being caught and released.

Now we'll have a look at this weeks bag board.

First up is Dave with a very healthy looking Lenthalls Barra.

SHOUT OUT!!!! A huge Thank You to Andrew from B&G Water Haulage for Donating 20,000 litres of water to Our Rural Fire Brigade Tank. We had used all the water at the big Bonnaroo burn. A huge thank you to Andrew!!! Well done SSRFB for all the work you have done in the last month. A great effort – a great team.

In Qld we have 1,401 Rural Fie Brigades, 31,244 Volunteers, and 493 Fire Stations. In the 20/21 Budget the forecast spend on Rural Fire Brigades was \$47.1 million. However, the total QFES income was estimated to be \$858.5 million. Rural Fire Brigades comprise the <u>largest service</u> in the department and yet receives only 5.48% of the QFES budget. To put this in context the Country Fire Service (CFS) in South Australia has only,13,509 volunteers and their budget in 20/21 was \$83.988 million. We have over 31,000 volunteers and our budget \$47.1 million. (From the RFBAQ's latest Smoke Signal magazine.) Sandy Straits RFB needs your help!! We run on a shoestring budget with a large area of the Cooloola Coast and villages to protect. When you see the yellow fire helmet at the Bar in the hall please put in some loose change!! Thank you for your support.


