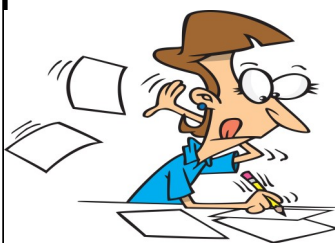

UPDATE:

Review of Zoning Plan Great Sandy Marine Park.

The Queensland Government has undertaken a review of the Great Sandy Marine Park. (INFORMATION BELOW TAKEN FROM QUEENSLAND GOVERNMENT DOCUMENT)

The proposed changes to the zoning plan seek to protect the significant values of the marine park while balancing the varied uses and aspirations identified through the review.

Recreational and charter fishing
Commercial fishing and supporting Industries.

Review Process

- Step 1. Information was gathered about the conservation, social, cultural and economic values of the marine park.
- Step 2. A public discussion paper was released and targeted consultation was undertaken to gain feedback on the management of the park.
- Step 3. A draft zoning plan was released for consultation. Analysis of feedback is underway. This is the current stage of the zoning plan review.
- Step 4. A final zoning plan will be prepared informed by feedback from the consultation.

We now wait for the final zoning plan to be released.

Exciting Boat Ramp:

Maritime Safety Queensland (MSQ) UPDATE:

Poona dredging feasibility study Maryborough

Investigate feasibility and costs for dredging an approach channel to the Owen Cox Street boat ramp and likely ongoing maintenance dredging frequency and costs, writing up of study findings.

Completed to date: hydrographic survey, preliminary approvals agency meetings, geotechnical sampling fieldwork and report.

In progress: assessment of geotechnical report, volume calculations, cost estimates for potential capital dredging
